1. Negro Faculty

(NOTE: In addition, the College has the following Asiatic peoples  
on its staff: one Indian, one Chinese, and two Philipinos.)

2. Negro Students

a. Undergraduate

- (1) 109 students recorded at registration representing 2.2% of  
undergraduates.
- (2) 498 did not respond at registration.
- (3) Projected estimate of 120 Negroes if one takes 2.2% of 498 not  
responding; more likely that College has closer to 140 if one  
assumes that many of 498 are of minority groups wishing to  
guard their privacy.

b. Graduate

- (1) 58 replied as being Negro at registration, representing  
4% of total.
- (2) 150 refused to fill out form.
- (3) Projected estimate of 64 Negroes if one takes 4% of 150 not  
responding; again could assume number closer to 75-80  
if privacy is being protected.

C. Conclusion

Estimate approximately 200-plus Negroes attending West Chester.  
In addition, the following additional minority groups are reported:

- 5 Orientals
- 2 African natives (Graduate, Negroes)
- 2 American Indians
- 1 Spanish American (presumed to be Puerto Rican)
